

Tribute to Lee Jackson

Lee Jackson was one of the founding members of Youngstown All Breed Training Club. Before the club was established, several people met and trained their dogs at Pioneer Pavilion in Mill Creek Park. They later moved to GF Hall on Logan Avenue in Youngstown to train. Lee spent many hours and much of his own money to keep this club active. He was known as "Mr. Youngstown All Breed" and served as president of YABTC for 18 years. Lee was also president of Mahoning Shenago Kennel Club.

Lee was an AKC judge and one of 3 people in the nation to receive the distinguished 1977 Midwest D'Ambris award. Unfortunately Lee passed away before he could receive the award.

Both Lee and his wife Kay competed in obedience with Dachshunds and Belgian Sheepdogs. Kay also was Trial Secretary for many years. They had three dogs titled as Companion dogs. Lee had a good sense of humor and had one of his wire haired Dachshunds registered with the name of "DAMMIT"

March of 1978, in honor of Lee Jackson the first Lee Jackson award was given in tribute of him and has become a yearly tradition of YABTC. This award is given to and outstanding and dedicated person who has served our club in honor of Lee Jackson.

Many years ago, one of members who received this award named it the "old person award", however this award is given to a hard-working individual who is willing to give back to the club without any expectation of payment in return for their service for their volunteer service to our organization.

2021 Lee Jackson recipient has been a member since 2012. Since joining the club this member has been very active and willing to help where ever he can. Always willing to listen and come up with possible solutions when we have issues. He has always here for building clean-ups and part of the housekeeping crew on Tuesday mornings, He has been instrumental with making sure our floors are clean and the equipment is working. He volunteered to help build courses for agility for both classes and trials. He helped with teaching classes at the club, sets up and

tear downs. He is always willing to step-up and help the club whenever he can.

This year our Lee Jackson recipient has been a member since May of 2000. She has participated in many aspects of the world of dogs and continues to give back to the sport. This member has worn many hats since coming to YABTC, helping to instruct classes, stewarding in the ring, helping to bring seminars, taking on secretarial duties for events, and sitting on committees when needed. She is at ringside to cheer you on and helps people problem solve to find solutions when they have training issues. Unfortunately, she is under the weather today and was not able to attend tonight's meeting.



Directions for handling scent work odors at YABTC

No odors should be placed on any agility, obedience, or other training equipment. This could cause an accident for our dogs that practice/compete in these other sports.

No kitchen items may be used in any search areas.

In order to have as clean of an environment as possible the following procedures should be followed:

If you use a solid surface item in a search area:

- 1. Always use a scent vessel. No naked Q-tips should be used.
- 2. After you remove the vessel, spray the item with the Zero Odor spray. Dry with a paper towel. Then place a small piece of painters' tape and mark the date on the tape. This will help with contamination of other chairs on the rack or other items in the space/room.
- 3. Upstairs you will find a plastic container with a lid marked Scent work "HOT" items. If you use something other than a cardboard box, spray with the Zero Odor spray, mark with the tape and place in the plastic container. Place any cold items back on the shelf upstairs.
- 4. Hot cardboard boxes can be placed in the trash.
- 5. If a hide is placed on the wall, make sure to stay inside our training area on the office side of the building. Do not place any odor tins on the wall out in the agility/obedience area.

It is very important to keep our hot and cold items separate! For the success of our scent trials, it is very important to maintain a clean environment.

Payment is required two weeks prior to the next agility session to hold a dog/handler team's spot in class.


